Stampnitzky studies the issue through the lens of the sociology of knowledge, stating that expert discourse on Disciplining Terror operates in a contested interstitial space between academic expertise, the state, and media. Expert discourses on bombings, kidnappings, and hijackings shifted from a framework organized around "insurgency" to one organized around the concept of "terrorism" - a shift that fundamentally transformed both understandings of Disciplining Terror violence and the scope

of possibilities for expert analysis of the phenomenon.
